Klein ISD Online Resources

Klein ISD provides online resources for all students and faculty. These resources are accessible from school and from home. Some of these resources require a username and password that are available from the campus librarian.



Overview of Klein ISD's Online Resources

Elementary Resources

***netTrekker** - A search engine designed for student use with links to websites evaluated by educators. For home use, students must register to obtain their personal username and password.

***ABC-CLIO** - Provides 3 databases: World History (1500 to Modern Era), American History, and World Geography.

***Encyclopedia Britannica** - Access to Elementary Encyclopedia and Britannica Learning Zone.

***EBSCO** - Provides access to age-appropriate materials through Searchasaurus and Kids Search.

***PebbleGo** - A database designed specifically for students in grades K-3. Reading and research tools are included that are developmentally appropriate for teaching skills to emergent readers.

***TumbleBooks** - A collection of animated picture books that teach children the joys of reading in an online format. This resource is most suitable for elementary students.

Visual Thesaurus - An interactive dictionary and thesaurus which creates word maps with meanings and related words. Appropriate for all students.

KISD's web-based catalog for younger students to search for library books and digital media.



eBooks

eBooks from the following vendors are available through the online library catalog or a link from the library webpage.

***Gale Virtual Reference Library** - reference materials such as encyclopedias, literary analyses, novel studies, science, environment, social science and history.

***Infobase** - non-fiction titles including biographies, literary analyses, health, history and specialized encyclopedias.

netLibrary - professional development and medical eBooks.

Secondary Resources

***Atomic Learning** - short tutorials on standard load applications. (HS only)

***SIRS Issues Researcher** - Includes thousands of full-text articles, charts, maps and illustrations that explore the pros and cons of current topics.

***Rosen Teen Health and Wellness** - Provides information on topics such as, diseases, drugs, alcohol, nutrition, fitness, mental health, diversity, and more.
